

Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks FAQs

How do I collect Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks?

Colonial Cash is handed out between April 15th and June 30th every year. Customers receive one unit (\$1) for every \$10 they spend during that time. Bonus Bucks are distributed from July 1st to August 24th every year. For Bonus Bucks, customers receive one unit for every \$10 they spend, or the amount of Colonial Cash they used, whichever is greater.

We do not typically distribute Colonial Cash for deliveries, but customers that paid for a delivery can bring in their receipt to collect their Colonial Cash. This only applies to deliveries during the collection period. Landscapers do not receive Colonial Cash.

What is the difference between Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks?

They work the same way, but they are distributed and redeemed during different dates.

When can I use Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks?

The listed redemption dates for Colonial Cash are July 1st to July 14th. The listed redemption dates for Bonus Bucks are August 25th to September 7th. We also extend these redemption periods an extra week every year. You can use any Colonial Cash or Bonus Bucks dated for that time or earlier during those redemption periods. We do not accept any Colonial Cash or Bonus Bucks outside of those six weeks.

How do I use Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks?

During the redemption periods, each unit of Colonial Cash or Bonus Bucks are worth \$1 and you can use them as cash for up to half your purchase. For example, if you spend \$10.59 on an eligible item, you can use up to \$5 worth of Colonial Cash. Your remaining balance would be \$5.59.

The lowest unit of Colonial Cash is \$1. These coupons cannot be exchanged for cash or used to make change. They cannot be combined with other sales or special offers or on certain services.

What can I use Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks on?

They can be used on any items in the store that are not on sale, custom orders, labor and delivery, or events. They cannot be combined with other coupons and special offers. In general, Colonial Cash is used for cash and carry items only. We cannot take Colonial Cash over the phone or on online orders.

Examples of what they can be used on:

Annuals, Perennials, Shrubs, Trees, and Houseplants
Bagged and Picked-Up Bulk Mulch
Christmas Ornaments

Fertilizers and Chemicals
Gifts, Fall Decorations, Candles
Pottery

What it can't be used on:

Sale Items (Clearance, Second Chance, Discounted Stock, Rain Barrels)
Custom Items (Floral Arrangements, Custom Planters)
Labor Fees (Delivery, Planting, Potting)
Delivered bulk products
Events (Butterfly Reservations)
DoorDash orders

Can I use old Colonial Cash or Bonus Bucks?

Yes. We accept expired Colonial Cash and Bonus Bucks during our yearly redemption periods. Don't ever throw out your coupons, since you can use them year after year.

Please note that there may be other exceptions to Colonial Cash.
